Your new Clarity AH200 amplified headphones are ready to provide high quality sound. Setup is easy and should take just a couple of minutes.

PAIRING TO YOUR MOBILE PHONE

- 1. Turn headset off, press and hold power button for seven (7) seconds until indicator flashes white and red.
- 2. Open the settings on your mobile phone so that it begins searching for new devices.
- 3. Select "Clarity200 Headset". If necessary, enter four zeroes (0000) for the passcode or accept the connection.
- ² 4. When headset flashes white only, it indicates that the headset is paired.

Make/Answer/End Calls While Paired to Mobile Phone Only:

- 1. To make a call: dial the number from the mobile phone.
- 2. To answer a call: you will hear an incoming call alert while listening to the TV. Press the Power button to answer. TV audio is muted during the call; streaming audio from the mobile phone is muted and paused.
- 3. To end a call: press the Power button to end the call. Headset returns to audio from mobile phone.
- 4. To decline a call: press and hold the "+" button for 2 seconds; you will resume the previous audio activity from before the incoming call. **Mute:** during a call, press the "-" button.


LISTENING TO MUSIC (from mobile phone)

When you use your headset to listen to music from your mobile phone, the left headphone includes buttons for pause/play, next, and back.

IMPORTANT: In order to preserve battery charge, we recommend turning off the headset when not in use.



Use the power adapter and cable to charge your headset. It takes up to 2.5 hours to fully charge your headset. The LED's turn off once charging is complete.
